COVID-19 CONTAINMENT ADVISORY FOR ALL KIMC STUDENTS

As schools re-open in January 2021, KIMC wishes to inform **ALL STUDENTS** they **MUST** observe the COVID-19 containment measures as prescribed by the Government. The Management would like to assure you that all the necessary arrangements have been put in place to ensure the students health safety.

The following measures have been put in place with immediate effect on your reporting date.

1. **Internal Communication and social activities**

- a) All students shall maintain 1.5 meters distance between themselves.
- b) Only **one** student shall be served in an office at any one given time.
- c) Unnecessary gatherings are not allowed.
- d) All forms of social activities such as games (pool game, darts, weight lifting, volleyball etc) are prohibited.
- e) Communication through calls, email and social media is preferred to paper and contact communication.
- f) Greetings will be done by waving is encouraged.

2. **Student Hygiene and Safety**

- a) All students and clients must at all times wear their face masks properly covering nose and mouth while at the institution. Used face masks must be disposed in the bins provided. Avoid littering used face masks anyhow.
- b) Hand wash basins have been provided for at entry points and students shall wash their hands frequently with soap and water and/or alcohol based Sanitizers. Use the hand washing facilities properly.
- c) There shall be a mandatory body temperature check for all students and clients entering into K.I.M.C
- d) All windows and doors shall be kept open whenever possible to make sure classes, labs and hostels are well ventilated.
- e) For students who would feel unwell or develop a common cold, cough or fever will be required to seek medical attention.

3. **Quarantine and Isolation**

- Any student exhibiting COVID-19 related symptoms should report immediately to the Clinic for further action.
- Any person who has tested positive for COVID-19 Virus must obtain the requisite Clearance from the Quarantine or isolation facility certified by the designated persons indicating that the person is free and safe from the COVID-19.

Regrettably, we will not grant you access to the institution should your temperature be above the normal level.

You are kindly requested to cooperate with Security staff and respective offices.

Note: Students who will be found violating these measures SHALL be suspended.
